Rules	This meet will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m and 2 heat for 400m and over events.		
Withdrawals Refunds	Any withdrawals requested prior to the closing of nominations will be fully refunded through Swim Central. After nominations have closed NO refunds will be processed.		
Events	As per the attached Program of Events. This meet to be conducted as timed finals. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, All Saints GC Swim Club reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations.
