Venue & Gate entry	Gold Coast AquaticMarine ParadeSouthportSpectators will be permitted access to the venue during the duration of the meet. Gate entry opens at 6.30am for spectators at a cost of \$3.40 per person (current at the time of writing).All swimmers, coaches, technical officials and volunteers will have their entry subsidised by Swimming Gold Coast.		
Spectator Attendance	Spectators are allowed in attendance; however, they will be placed on the top deck viewing area, whilst swimmers, coaches, technical officials and team managers will be on the pool deck. We are aiming to encourage club pride, team spirit and enhance the atmosphere of the Sprint Championships by placing swimmers together with their clubmates and friends on the day, whilst parents and spectators can cheer on from a better vantage point. Anyone on Pool Deck MUST have a QLD Blue Card.		
Late entries	Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.		
Age Requirements	Age as at 19 th November 2023. 8yrs is the minimum age for these championships.		
Status	This is a Swimming Queensland sanctioned Qualifying Meet.		
Entry Eligibility	All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer (on Swim Central) to nominate for this SKINS event. 'Recreational' swimmers entries are ineligible. Qualifying Times There are no qualifying times for this event.		

Multi –class events	 Multi-Class Swimmers must be registered as 'competitive' swimmers with a Gold Coast club and have a classification card. Your classification number/s must be registered against your swimmers record in Swim Central. Due to the insufficient number of para-swimmers on the Gold Coast, MC swimmers are more than welcome, however, there is unfortunately no specific MC events. 			
Visiting swimmers	Visiting Swimmers are welcome.			
Events	As per attached Program of Events. 8-9yr old and MC events will be swum as combined timed final events. There will be no finals for these groups. Heats only will be swum in each event. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, Swimming Gold Coast reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. Swimming Gold Coast also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events. Qualifying times for all events will be enforced.			
Further Communication	In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees within the program, including volunteer requirements.			
Warmup	Warmup will commence as follows: Session 1: 7.00am Lanes will be available in the training pool for additional warmup facilities. Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 0 and 9 from 7:30am. After commencement of the Championships, there will be 2 lanes available in the 50m training pool for warm-up and cool-down.			
Marshalling	All swim meets in the Gold Coast Region are self-Marshalling, however: ALL finalists, will be required to Marshall for the finals sessions only. There are NO reserves and we are on a strict time limit. If you are not at the blocks ready for your final – you will miss out!!!			
Rules This event will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "SQ Championship By-Laws", "FINA rules. Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-n zone 5 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone at least 6 heats prior to the scheduled.				
Backstroke Ledges	Backstroke ledges will be made available to swimmers in the 11yrs & over Backstroke events only.
