Printed programs will be provided for officials only. An official levy of \$2.50 per swimmer will be charged upon entry via Swim Central and passed through to Swimming Gold Coast technical officials.

Venue & Gate entry	All Saints Anglican School – Highfield Drive Merrimac Gold Coast QLD In our 8 lane 25m Heated (27deg) Swimming Pool complex. Spectators, Competitors, Coaches, and Children are all free
Spectator Attendance	This event is open to spectators . All Saints GC Swim Club encourages individuals considered at higher risk (including those aged 70 years and over , or with pre-existing medical or autoimmune conditions) to consider not attending the swim meet.
Late entries	Late entries WILL NOT be accepted, under any circumstances.
Age Requirements	Age as of Saturday 28th March 2026 6yrs to 11yrs of age for this meet.
Status	This is a Swimming Queensland and Swimming Gold Coast Sanctioned Qualifying meet.
Entry Cap	This meet is capped at 5 hours regardless of swimmer numbers. (based on first swimmers to register) If cap is reached prior to close NO waitlist will be used, but any refunds requested will be approved daily. Which will open events back up on swim central Contact msabotic123@gmail.com for more information. Swimmers are only able to enter a maximum of 6 individual events at this meet.
Entry Eligibility	All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer on Swim Central to nominate for the Brauer Short Course Development Meet 'Recreational' swimmers are ineligible to enter. No QT times for any event at this meet
Withdrawals Refunds	Any withdrawals requested prior to the closing of nominations will be fully refunded through Swim Central. After nominations have closed NO refunds will be processed

<p>Medals & Awards</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place medals will be awarded for all 8, 9, 10, and 11 year age-group events. No additional places will be awarded in rule tolerance events, except for the 25m Freestyle rule tolerance event, where every swimmer will receive a medal. <p>Age Champions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Age Champions will be recognised at this meet based on results from 50m, 100m, and 200m events, where available within the swimmer's age group. Points will be awarded as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1st place: 5 points 2nd place: 3 points 3rd place: 1 point
<p>Collection of medals</p>	<p>Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Items not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.</p>
<p>Photography & images</p>	<p>In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland and/or Swimming Gold Coast approved photographers. Any images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet. They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast, and affiliated clubs at their discretion.</p>
<p>Warm up</p>	<p>Warm up will commence at 7.45am Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 1 and 8 from 8.15am</p>
<p>Food</p>	<p>All Saints Gold Coast Swimming Club will be operating a BBQ along with selling cold drinks. Coffee, tea, and cakes will also be on sale.</p>
<p>Timekeepers</p>	<p>All Saints GC Swim Club will again endeavour to fill all timekeeping spots, but in the event, we run short we will require clubs to supply some, and they will be notified in the week prior.</p>
