



2025 Swimming Gold Coast Championships

You are cordially invited to attend the 2025 Swimming Gold Coast Championships to be conducted at the Gold Coast Aquatic Centre.

Date	Friday 28 th February 2025 Saturday 1 st March 2025 Sunday 2 nd March 2025
Time	Warmup will commence as follows: Friday – 4.30pm warm-up for 5.30pm start (may change due to entries) Saturday - 2.00pm warm-up for 3.00pm start (may change due to entries) Sunday – 8.00am warm-up for 9.00am start Lanes will be available in the training pool for additional warmup facilities. Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 0 and 9.
Venue & Gate entry	Gold Coast Aquatic Centre Marine Parade Southport Spectators will be permitted access to the venue during the duration of the meet. Gate entry opens at 30min prior to warm-up for spectators at a cost of \$3.50 per person (current at the time of writing). All swimmers, coaches, technical officials, and volunteers will have their entry subsidised by Swimming Gold Coast.
Spectator Attendance	Spectators are allowed in attendance; however, they are required to find seating on the top deck viewing area, whilst swimmers, coaches, technical officials, and team managers will be on the pool deck. We are aiming to encourage club pride, team spirit and enhance the atmosphere of the Championships by placing swimmers together with their clubmates and friends on the day, whilst parents and spectators can cheer on from a better vantage point.
Nomination fee	\$12.00 per event individual event (incl. GST) + associated Swim Central fees. \$2.00 swimmer surcharge to cover the cost of officials. Includes digital program. #Refunds will only be provided up to the nomination closing date (Saturday 22 nd February). Any refund request after this time MUST be accompanied with a medical certificate. This needs to be provided by 5pm on Tuesday 4 th March and MUST include the dates of the meet.
Nominations period	Open: Saturday 11th January 2025 @ 9:00am Close: Saturday 22nd February 2025 @ 11.59pm. All entries must be submitted through swim central #No Manual entries will be accepted unless from international swimmers #
Late entries	Late entries will be accepted up until Tuesday 25th February at a cost of an additional \$50 per swimmer.
Age Requirements	Age as at 28 th February 2025. 8yrs is the minimum age for these championships.
Status	This is a Swimming Queensland sanctioned Qualifying Meet.



<p>Entry Eligibility</p>	<p>All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer (on Swim Central) in order to nominate for these Championships. ‘Recreational’ swimmers are ineligible to enter.</p> <p>Qualifying times must have been achieved after January 1st 2023 at an approved qualifying meet. Club night, club championships, no times (NT) are NOT and WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.</p> <p>Entries will not be accepted unless the qualifying times have been swum at a sanctioned Short Course or Long Course Qualifying Meet prior to this Championships’ closing date. Short Course converted times can be used, however, converted short course qualifying times will only be used where an existing long course qualifying time has not been achieved.</p>
<p>Multi – class events</p>	<p>Multi-Class Swimmers must be registered as ‘competitive’ swimmers with a Gold Coast club. Your classification number/s must be registered against your swimmers record in Swim Central.</p> <p>All events are for 10 years & over and run as Open events. <u>There are no qualifying times for any MC specific events.</u></p> <p># Please note – Multi-class swimmers without a registered classification will be allowed to swim as an Exhibition swimmer only.</p>
<p>Visiting swimmers</p>	<p>This Meet is a closed Meet for members that are registered with Gold Coast Swimming Clubs ONLY.</p> <p>Invitations have also been extended to clubs from the region of Swimming North Coast NSW, however, as visitors, they are not eligible for medals or points.</p> <p>International Swimmers that are training at Gold Coast Pools will be provided with exemption to swim at this event. All swimming members of another federation must enter manually through the SGC Race Secretary. Training confirmation must be provided by the coach. As visitors, they are not eligible for medals or points.</p>
<p>Swimming Gold Coast Annual Awards</p>	<p>Swimmers registered with Swimming Gold Coast should compete at these Championships to be eligible to gain points for our Annual Awards including Rising Star, Presidents Award, Age Group Awards, Swimmer of Stroke & Coach’s Award. More information about these awards is available on our website.</p> <p>Swimming Gold Coast Website</p> <p>Swimmers with Swimming Qld or Swimming Australia commitments will be given special exemption if unable to attend.</p> <p>Points will be allocated in accordance with the Swimming Gold Coast Awards Criteria.</p>
<p>Marshalling</p>	<p>All swim meets in the Gold Coast Region are self-marshalling.</p>
<p>Backstroke Ledges</p>	<p>Backstroke ledges will be available for swimmers aged 12yrs and over to utilise in all backstroke events. Ledges will also be available for MC swimmers.</p>
<p>Events</p>	<p>As per attached Program of Events.</p> <p>These Championships are to be conducted as timed finals. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, Swimming Gold Coast reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. Swimming Gold Coast also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and / or events. Qualifying times for all events will be enforced.</p>

<p>Rules</p>	<p>These championships will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "World Aquatics" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules.</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m and 2 heats for 400m and over events.</p> <p>All events of 400m and over (400m IM, 400m Free, 800m Free and 1500m Free) require swimmers (or their Coach / Team Manager) to confirm their intention to swim through the supplied QR Code a minimum of one hour prior to the published start time of the relevant event. Failure to confirm their intention to swim may be taken as a withdrawal. Confirmed swimmers should then follow the self-marshalling procedures. Any reseeded events will be notified through announcements.</p> <p>Swimmers competing in the 800m and 1500m Freestyle events MUST provide details of their lap counter & timekeeper whilst checking in. Swimmers will not be able to check-in without confirmation of an organised lap counter & timekeeper.</p> <p>Queries regarding any disqualification MUST be made by a club coach or club official only. Technical officials will not be made available to any parents / spectators regarding swimmer disqualification.</p>
<p>Results</p>	<p>Swimming Gold Coast Club point score will be in place.</p> <p>Age Champions will be recognised and awarded to each age group from 8yrs to 17yrs & Over, from all events in each age group and will be presented at the conclusion of the meet. A minimum of 3 events in their age group must be swum to be eligible. An individual point score for all placings will be used for these championships. All individual swimmers, who swim in an event, will accrue a minimum of 1 point for their club.</p> <p><i>Only the top 8 performances will contribute to their overall standing.</i></p> <p>1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in all Timed Finals. Medals will only be awarded to placegetters within the qualifying time.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded to ages 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 & Over in all 50m events.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded to ages 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 & Over in all 100m events, 200m Freestyle and 200m IM.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded to ages 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 & Over in all 200m form stroke, 400m Freestyle and IM Freestyle events.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded to ages 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 & Over in the 800m Freestyle.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded to ages 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 & Over in all 1500m Freestyle.</p> <p>Medals will only be awarded to placegetters within the qualifying time from the timed finals.</p> <p>For Multi-Class swimmers, medals/points will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place using the 2024-25 Swimming Australia Multi-Class Points System.</p> <p><i>Only the top 8 performances will contribute to their overall standing.</i></p>

Collection of medals	<p>Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.</p>
Meet Mobile	<p>Results may be published in near real time during this meet via the Meet Mobile application.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used as a guide only. • Official meet results are printed by officials during all meets and posted in a prominent position. <p>Official results are also published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet upon the Swimming Gold Coast website event pages and the Swim Australia Results Portal.</p> <p>SGC Meet Results Page</p> <p>Swimming Australia Results Portal</p>
VOLUNTEERS	<p>The following volunteer roles will be allocated to clubs on Monday 24th February 2025 after the closing of nominations. Please register your interest with your club.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timekeepers (2 per lane per day) – Allocated on a per session basis • Chief Timekeepers (1 per day) – Allocated on a per session basis • Medal Presenters (2 each day) – Allocated on a per session basis • Catering Distributors (2 each day) – Allocated on a per session basis • Results Runners (1 each day) – Allocated on a per session basis <p>Further opportunities for parents to assist at the Championships involve helping their clubs as a team manager. The role of the team manager is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supervising all swimmers from the club, especially those 17yrs & under. • Monitoring the COVID responsibilities of your club at the meet. • Supporting the coach(es) in matters relating to the swimmers. • Ensuring swimmers know what, when and where for seating, warm-up, self-marshalling, racing and warm-down and being present for these. • Being a point of contact for drop-off of swimmers. • Ensuring ALL swimmers are collected and marked off upon exit from the facility. • Have relevant emergency contact details for each swimmer. • Commit to the time required to fulfil the role <p>All team managers MUST have a valid working with children blue card.</p>
Photography & images	<p>In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club approved photographers, that the images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet, and that they may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club at its discretion.</p>
Food	<p>Swimming Gold Coast will be hosting a BBQ throughout the event, with the assistance of a nominated Swim Club. A detailed menu will be provided in the meet program.</p> <p>Also, Café Catalina will be open to swimmers and spectators throughout the event.</p>



Technical Officials	<p>All technical officials will be contacted to register their availability, for any day by Chief Referee, Sharon Wicking.</p> <p>Any persons interested in learning about the possibilities of becoming a Technical Official, please make contact with the Swimming Gold Coast Chief Referee Sharon Wicking at: chiefreferee@swimminggoldcoast.org.au for communication on the opportunities available and any training requirements.</p>
Pool Compliance	<p>The Gold Coast Aquatic Centre has undertaken compliance testing and met all current competitive pool standards, as set by Swimming Australia. Gold Coast pool certifications can be viewed here.</p>
Competitive Dive Policy	<p>All swimming competitors and/or their parents, accept that, by nominating for this event, that they have read and understand Swimming Australia’s “Dive Entry for Competitive Swimming Policy” and the swimmer(s) meet the dive competency levels outlined in that policy.</p>
FURTHER COMMUNICATION	<p>In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information regarding the Championships will be provided to all participants and attendees. This will include facility maps, seating requirements and any further information as required.</p>
Code of Conduct	<p>By entering this swim meet all swimmers and attendees agree to adhere to the Swimming Gold Coast code of conduct. The code of conduct can be found at the following link. CODE OF CONDUCT LINK</p>
Force Majeure	<p>In the case of force majeure preventing or resulting in the 2025 SGC Championships being cancelled, refund of registration fees will be at the discretion of Swimming Gold Coast.</p>
