Visiting Swimmers	Inter-State swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their surname and the club they are registered with.	
	Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form.	
	There will be no manual entries accepted.

In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m.

Further Communication	In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees within the program. This will include the entry list, timeline and finalised meet program, which will outline all meet specific requirements, seating allocations, food availability, club volunteer requirements etc.	
	Events of 400m and over (400m IM, 400m Free, 800m Free, 1500m Free) require swimmers to confirm their intention to swim. This must be completed at the Help Desk a minimum of one hour prior to the published start time of the relevant event (confirmation times will be published in the program).	
Swimmer check- in requirements	Any swimmer (either by themselves, coach or team manager) who has not confirmed their intention to swim one hour prior to the published start time for the relevant event WILL BE DEEMED A WITHDRAWAL AND THE EVENT WILL BE RESEEDED IF POSSIBLE.	
	Swimmers competing in the 800m and 1500m Freestyle events MUST provide details of their lap counter & timekeeper whilst checking in.	
	All swim meets within the Gold Coast region are self-marshalling.	
Marshalling	Competitors in the first 2 events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone 4 heats prior to their own heat.	
Photography & Images	In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland and/or Swimming Gold Coast approved photographers. Any images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet. They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and affiliated clubs at their discretion.	
Timekeepers & Volunteers	Timekeepers, Technical Officials, check starters and volunteers will be required to be provided by each club, where available. A schedule will be provided to the clubs by the Emmanuel College Swimming Club.	
Results	Age Champions will not be recognised at this meet. 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats.

Medals will be awarded to the following Age Groups: 8, 9, 10, 11 for 50, 100 and 200 metre individual events only. There will be no medals or places awarded for 25 metre events. All participants in 25 metre events will receive participation ribbons.	
The 400m, 800m and 1500m events will be swum as open events, these will not be multi-aged.	
Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.	
Results may be published in near real time during this meet via the Meet Mobile application. Please note:	
 Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used as a guide only. Official meet results are printed by officials during all meets and posted in a prominent position. 	
Official results are also published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet upon the Swimming Gold Coast website and Swim Central.
