In addition, competitors should be in the marshalling area at least two events ahead of the event in progress.</p> <p>All attendees must abide by SGC Code of Conduct.</p>
<p>Timekeepers</p>	<p>Timekeepers will be required to be provided by each club. A timekeeping schedule will be provided at a ratio dependant on the number of swimmers attending.</p>
