Nominations Close	1 <sup>st</sup> September 2024 at 11.59pm - No Refunds will be given once entries have closed – Currently No Restriction on number of swimmers.		
Age Determination	Age as at 7 <sup>th</sup> September 2024		
Entries	All entries <b>must be submitted through Swim Central or requests via your Club's Race</b> Secretary. There is a 6 hour cap on this event and swimmers can swim a maximum of 6 events.		
Eligibility	This Meet is for Swimming Australia 'Competitive' registered swimmers. 'Recreational' swimmers are ineligible to enter.		
	As per below Program of Events.		
Events	Heats only will be swum in each event. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, the reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. The club also reserves the right, or day, to combine heats and events.		
Late Entries	Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary and a discretional fee of \$50 per event can be applied. All enquiries regarding these entries <u>MUST</u> only come through the attending club's Race Secretary and not through individuals.		
Collections of Awards	Collection of medals/prizes is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals/prizes not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.		
Visiting Swimmers	Refer to Swimming Queensland policy.		
Results	Age Champions will be not be recognised. 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded for 50m & 100m races in the following ages 10,11,12,13,14,15 years & over. 200m & 400m events medals will not be awarded in age groups. Medals must be collected on the day of the meet.		



Rules	This event will be conducted under: the Swimming Queensland General Rules, SQ Championship By-Laws, FINA and SAL rules		
	Competitors in the first two events should be in the marshalling area 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, competitors should be in the marshalling area at least two events ahead of the event in progress.		
	All attendees must abide by SGC Code of Conduct.		
Timekeepers	Timekeepers will be required to be provided by each club. A timekeeping schedule will be provided at a ratio dependant on the number of swimmers attending.
