



# Terms and Conditions

## Swimming Gold Coast Super Swim League 2022

These terms and conditions (**Terms**) govern your purchase of entry for, and attendance at the Inaugural Swimming Gold Coast Super Swim League (**Event**). It is your responsibility to review these Terms prior to registering for entry. By registering you agree to be bound by these Terms. We reserve the right to amend these Terms at any time and will provide the most recent version on our website.

Throughout these Terms, the terms “SGC Super Swim League”, “SGC SSL”, “we”, “us” and “our” refer to Gold Coast Regional Swimming Association Inc., and “you” refers to the individual purchasing tickets for the Event.

<b>Event Dates</b>	<b>Round 1</b> – Friday September 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 2022 <b>Round 2</b> – Friday September 9 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 <b>Round 3</b> – Friday September 16 <sup>th</sup> , 2022
<b>Event Times</b>	Each round will follow the following time guide <b>Gate Entry</b> – 4:45pm <b>Warm-up</b> – 5:00pm to 5:50pm <b>Racing</b> – 6:00pm to 7:30pm In water warm down facilities are not available for round 2.
<b>Venue</b>	<b>Round 1</b> – Emmanuel College – College Dr, Carrara <b>Round 2</b> – All Saints Anglican College – Highfields Dr, Merrimac <b>Round 3</b> – Bond University – Ring Rd, Robina
<b>Course</b>	All rounds will be of a short course format
<b>Gate Entry</b>	Gates will open from 4.45pm. Spectators will be permitted access at \$5 per entry (11yrs and under free). All swimmers, coaches, technical officials, and volunteers will have their entry subsidised by Swimming Gold Coast.
<b>Spectator Seating</b>	Spectators will be provided a separate seating area from the teams. Spectators are not able to sit within the SGC SSL team groups.
<b>Entry fee</b>	<b>\$90.00</b> per swimmer (incl. GST) <b>\$2.02</b> transaction costs These fees will be paid during registration through our payment processing partner Square - Square AU Pty Ltd., ABN 38 167 106 176, AFSL 513929. All payments are bound by the terms and Conditions of ‘Square’ - <a href="#">HERE</a>



<b>Entry Registration close</b>	<b>Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022 @ 9:00pm</b> All entries <b>must be submitted through the applicable JotForm link – not SwimCentral</b> <b>#No Manual entries will be accepted#</b>
<b>Late entries</b>	<b>Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of SGC</b>
<b>Swimmer Withdrawal</b>	Fees will only be refunded if a swimmer is withdrawn from the entire event prior to 5pm August 26 <sup>th</sup> , 2022.
<b>Entry Rules</b>	Swimmers MUST commit to competing at all three rounds
<b>Team Selections</b>	Teams will be selected by the SGC management Committee
<b>Age / Entry Requirements</b>	Age as at 2 <sup>nd</sup> September 2022. Age categories for the SGC Super Swim League are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>🏊 11-12yrs (max. 24 Female &amp; 24 Male swimmers)</li> <li>🏊 13-14yrs (max. 24 Female &amp; 24 Male swimmers)</li> <li>🏊 15yrs &amp; over (max. 24 Female &amp; 24 Male swimmers)</li> <li>🏊 Multi-class – Open category (max. 4 swimmers)</li> </ul>
<b>Status</b>	This is a Swimming Gold Coast and Swimming Queensland sanctioned Qualifying Meet.
<b>Marshalling</b>	The SGCSSL is a self-marshalled event and will be monitored by teams’ managers.
<b>Entry Eligibility</b>	All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer with Swimming Gold Coast to nominate for this event. All Swimmers must be fully paid 2022-23 members prior to the first round.
<b>Multi – Class</b>	Only 4 Multi-Class swimmers are eligible to enter and only in the Multi-Class category. Multi-Class swimmers only may swap out with another multi-class swimmer if they are unable to fulfil all 3 meet commitments. <b>Swimming Gold Coast Super Swim League Awards</b>	At the completion of the SGC Super Swim League a presentation evening will be held at a yet to be determined time and place, where the following categories will be awarded: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>🏊 Team swimmer of the event (1 award per team – decided by coaches)</li> <li>🏊 Team spirit award (1 award per team – decided by coaches)</li> <li>🏊 Team coaches’ choice award (1 award per team – decided by coaches)</li> <li>🏊 Each member of the overall winning team will also receive an award (determined by final point scores).</li> </ul>
<b>Program of Events</b>	Each rounds program of events will be determined by SGC, and released as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>🏊 Round 1 – Monday 18<sup>th</sup> July</li> <li>🏊 Round 2 – Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September</li> <li>🏊 Round 3 – Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September</li> </ul>
<b>Rules</b>	These championships will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules. Race day events within the program may not consist of the usual structure (relay and combination races). The rules surrounding these races still applies to the FINA “rules of Swimming” and each stroke must be undertaken in accordance with the rules governing that stroke. Queries regarding any disqualification <b>MUST</b> be made by a team coach or manager only. Technical officials will not be made available to any parents / spectators regarding swimmer disqualification.
<b>Backstroke Ledges</b>	Backstroke ledges will not be available for any round of the SGC Super Swim League.



<p><b>Points System</b></p>	<p>The following point scoring system will be in place for the Swimming Gold Coast Super Swim League.</p> <p>Individual races – 1<sup>st</sup> – 12pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 10pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> – 6pts, 5<sup>th</sup> – 4pts, 6<sup>th</sup> – 3pts, 7<sup>th</sup> – 2pts, 8<sup>th</sup> – 1pt</p> <p>Relay races – Double points</p> <p>Combination races – as per individual races for the first component, then additional points (as per the individual or relay race point scoring system) for the final result of the race.</p> <p>For Multi-Class placings will be awarded using the Swimming Australia Multi-Class Points System. Additional points, to determine the individual race winner, will be added due to age in the following structure:</p> <p>18yrs &amp; over – as per original</p> <p>17yrs – points + 10%</p> <p>16yrs – points + 20%</p> <p>15yrs – points + 30%</p> <p>14yrs – points + 40%</p> <p>11-13yrs – points + 50%</p> <p>The <b>SGC Super Swim League winner</b> will be the team with the most points at the completion of the 3 rounds.</p>
<p><b>Missing swimmers</b></p>	<p>If teams are missing swimmers in any race due to no-show or late withdrawal – teams will be awarded 0 points for that race.</p>
<p><b>Reserves</b></p>	<p>If swimmers selected on a team are withdrawn prior to Thursday before the round, due to illness, they may be replaced by another swimmer from outside the team, with the permission of SGC.</p>
<p><b>Meet Mobile</b></p>	<p>Due to the complexities of the program of events, the results will not be published on the Meet Mobile application for any round of the SGC Super Swim League.</p> <p>Official results are published within 24hrs of the completion of a round upon the Swimming Gold Coast SSL web page <a href="https://www.swimminggoldcoast.org.au/">https://www.swimminggoldcoast.org.au/</a> and all relevant qualifying results will be uploaded to Swim Central.</p>
<p><b>Team Managers</b></p>	<p>Opportunities are available for parents to assist, by being a Team Manager (2 per team) – required for all 3 rounds – will receive team shirt and free entry to the facility. Please register your interest with: <a href="mailto:development@swimminggoldcoast.org.au">development@swimminggoldcoast.org.au</a>.</p> <p>The role of the team manager is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supervising all swimmers from the club, especially those 17yrs &amp; under.</li> <li>• Supporting the coach(es) in matters relating to the swimmers.</li> <li>• Ensuring swimmers know what, when and where for seating, warm-up, self-marshalling, racing and warm-down and being present for these.</li> <li>• Being a point of contact for drop-off of swimmers.</li> <li>• Ensuring ALL swimmers are collected and marked off upon exit from the facility.</li> <li>• Have relevant emergency contact details for each swimmer (provided by SGC).</li> <li>• Commit to the time required to fulfil the role</li> </ul> <p>All team managers MUST have a valid working with children blue card – <a href="#">link here</a>.</p>
<p><b>Volunteers</b></p>	<p>SGC SSL will be searching for volunteers to fulfil the following roles for each round. (entry to the round will be free) Please register your interest with <a href="mailto:development@swimminggoldcoast.org.au">development@swimminggoldcoast.org.au</a>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Timekeepers (2 per lane) – 16 in total per round</li> <li>• Chief Timekeepers (1) – per round</li> </ul>



<b>Communication</b>	Once teams are selected, all specific SGC Super League information will be distributed via TeamApp, including Team Programs, any specific team notes, event information, round specific information etc.
<b>Photography &amp; images</b>	In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and approved photographers. Those images may be displayed for viewing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet, and that they may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast at its discretion.
<b>Food</b>	The host facility swim club will be hosting a BBQ throughout the round. A detailed menu will be provided in the particular round information distributed in the week prior to each round.
<b>Technical Officials</b>	All technical officials will be contacted to register their availability, by Chief Referee, Sharon Wicking. <b>Pool Compliance</b>	All event facilities have undertaken compliance testing and met all current competitive pool standards, as set by Swimming Australia. Gold Coast pool certifications can be viewed <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>Competitive Dive Policy</b>	All swimming competitors and/or their parents, accept that, by nominating for this event, that they have read and understand Swimming Australia's "Dive Entry for Competitive Swimming Policy" and the swimmer(s) meet the dive competency levels outlined in that policy. This policy can be found <a href="#">here</a> .
<b>FURTHER COMMUNICATION</b>	In the week preceding each round, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees.
<b>Code of Conduct</b>	By entering this swim meet all swimmers and attendees agree to adhere to the Swimming Gold Coast code of conduct. The code of conduct can be found at the following link. <a href="#">CODE OF CONDUCT LINK</a>
<b>Force Majeure</b>	In the case of force majeure preventing or resulting in any round of the SGC Super Swim League being cancelled, postponed or delayed, the refund of registration fees (or part thereof) will be at the discretion of Swimming Gold Coast.
