Nomination Fee & Officials Levy	\$9.50 (incl GST) per individual event + associated Swim Central fees. Includes digital program. Printed programs will be provided for coaches and officials An official levy of \$2 per swimmer will be charged upon entry in Swim Central – this will be passed through to SGC technical officials.
Venue & Gate entry	Venue & Address Gold Coast Aquatic Centre Marine Parade Southport Each club will be allocated tent spaces – tents can be erected on the days of competition only. The GCAC entry fee is \$3.20 for spectators. Please note that the GCAC is a cashless venue. Competitors, registered volunteers & registered coaches are free.
Spectator Attendance	All spectators and competitors will comply with GCAC entry conditions. Swimming Gold Coast encourages people considered high risk (aged 70+, have pre-existing medical or auto-immune conditions etc.) not to attend the swim meet.
Entries	Nominations close Friday January 27 at 23:59 on Swim Central or until the swimmer cap of 350 is met. All entries must be submitted through swim central #No manual entries will be accepted, except approved visiting swimmers, as below#
Late entries	Late entries WILL NOT be accepted under any circumstances.
Age Requirements	Age as of Friday February 3 2023 12yrs is the minimum age for this club meet.



Status	This is a Swimming Queensland and Swimming Gold Coast sanctioned Qualifying meet.
Code of conduct	By entering this swim meet all swimmers and attendees agree to adhere to the Swimming Gold Coast code of conduct. The code of conduct can be found at the following link. CODE OF CONDUCT LINK
Entry Eligibility	<p>All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer on Swim Central to nominate for this 2023 SOSC PSC Combined Meet.</p> <p>‘Recreational’ swimmers are ineligible to enter.</p> <p>Qualifying times must have been achieved after January 1st 2021 at an approved qualifying meet. Club night, club championships and no times (NT) are NOT ACCEPTABLE.</p> <p>Entries will not be accepted unless the qualifying times have been swum and approved at a sanctioned Short Course or Long Course Qualifying Meet prior to this meets’ closing date.</p> <p>Long Course / short course converted times (whichever is applicable) can be used, however, these will only be used where an existing short course / long course (whichever is applicable) qualifying time has not been achieved.</p>
Visiting swimmers	<p>Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, or from Interstate, are permitted to swim.</p> <p>A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their first name and the Federation they are registered with.</p> <p>Inter-State swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their surname and the club they are registered with.</p> <p>Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form.</p> <p>There will be no manual entries accepted.</p>
Entry Cap	Swimmers are only able to enter a maximum of 8 events at this meet.
Events	<p>As per the attached Program of Events.</p> <p>This meet to be conducted as timed finals. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, SOSC & PSC reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. SOSC & PSC in consultation with the chief referee, also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and / or events.</p>
Withdrawals / Refunds	Any withdrawals requested prior to the closing of nominations will be fully refunded through Swim Central. After nominations have closed, all withdrawals prior to the day of competition will be refunded at the discretion of SOSC.



Rules	<p>This meet will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m and 2 heats for 400m and over events.</p>
Technical Officials	<p>All technical officials will be contacted to register their availability, for either day, or both by Chief Referee, Sharon Wicking.</p> <p>Any persons interested in learning about the possibilities of becoming a Technical Official, please make contact with the Swimming Gold Coast Chief Referee Sharon Wicking at: chiefreferee@swimminggoldcoast.org.au for communication on the opportunities available and any training requirements.</p>
Further Communication	<p>In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees within the program. This will include drop-off and collection zone, facility maps, contact tracing procedures (if required), seating requirements and any further information as required.</p>
Swimmer Check-in Requirements	<p>Events of 400m and over (400m IM, 400m Free ,800m and 1500m Free) require swimmers (or their Coach / Team Manager) to confirm their intention to swim. This must be completed at the Help Desk a minimum of one hour prior to the published start time of the relevant event. Failure to confirm their intention to swim will be taken as a withdrawal. Confirmed swimmers should then follow the self-marshalling procedures.</p> <p>Prior to the meet, events of 400m and over will be seeded from nominations as normal.</p> <p>Any swimmer who has not confirmed their intention to swim one hour prior to the published start time for the relevant event will be deemed a withdrawal and the event will be reseeded.</p>
Marshalling	<p>All swim meets within the Gold Coast region are self-marshalling.</p>
Meet Mobile	<p>Results will be published throughout this meet to the Meet Mobile application.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used as a guide only. • Official meet results are printed by officials during the meet and posted in a prominent position. <p>Official results are published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet on the Swimming Gold Coast website and Swim Central.</p>



Results	<p>1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded as detailed below.</p> <p>For the 50m, 100m & 200m events medals will be awarded in age groups applicable to that event – 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 years & Over.</p> <p>In the 12 years & over 400, 800m & 1500m events, medals will not be awarded in age groups.</p> <p>Age Champions will not be recognised.</p>
Collection of medals	Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.
Timekeepers & Volunteers & TO's	Timekeepers, Technical Officials and check starters will be required to be provided by each club, where available. A schedule will be provided to the clubs by SOSC Swim Club with all team manager's, check starters and timekeepers to be allocated to clubs by SOSC.
Photography & images	In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland and/or Swimming Gold Coast approved photographers. Any images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet. They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and affiliated clubs at their discretion.
Warmup	<p>Warmup will commence as follows:</p> <p>Friday: 5.00pm in main competition pool</p> <p>Saturday: 7.00am in main competition pool</p> <p>Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 0 and 9.</p> <p>Warmup and Cool down will be available in allocated lanes in the old competition pool once events commence.</p>
Food	<p>There will be a BBQ being run by SOSC on Friday and Saturday.</p> <p>Café Catalina (a SOSC sponsor) has a range of hot/cold beverages and meal options available throughout the day.</p>
Volunteers & Team Managers	<p>The following volunteer roles will be allocated to clubs by Thursday February 2 following the closing of nominations. Please register your interest with your club.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timekeepers – Allocated on a per session basis- separate allocation for Events 33-34 (800m) • Lap counter for each clubs competitor in the 800m & 1500m events. • SOSC & PSC will be supplying volunteers to install backstroke ledges for all backstroke events
