



Pimpama Swimming Club Development Meet 2025

Date	Sunday 23rd November 2025.
Time	7.00am gates open, 7:30am warm-up for an 8.30am start.
Nomination fee	\$9.50 per event + online charges Includes digital program. \$2.50 per swimmer, a technical official levy is also a requirement of entry.
Nominations close	Nomination close 13/11/2025 at 11.59pm. All entries must be submitted through swim central. No manual entries will be accepted. No Refunds will be given once entries have closed
Entry Cap	NOTE: This meet is capped at 4 hours and swimmers can swim a maximum of 6 events . Entries will close on Swim Central once the cap is met.
Venue & Gate entry	Pimpama Sport Hub – 139 Rifle Range Road, Pimpama 4209. Spectators enter via the main pool entrance. Gate entry costs for spectators – \$3.70 All coaches, technical officials and swimmers will be given free entry.
Late entries	Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary and a discretionary one-off fee of \$50.00 will be applied. All enquiries regarding these entries MUST only come through the attending club's Race Secretary and not through individuals.
Age Requirements	Age as of the date of the meet. 8yrs is the minimum age for this meet.
Status	This is a Swimming Queensland and Swimming Gold Coast Sanctioned Qualifying meet.
Code of conduct	By entering this swim meet all swimmers and attendees agree to adhere to the Swimming Gold Coast code of conduct. The code of conduct can be found at the following link
Entry Eligibility	All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer on Swim Central to nominate for the 2025 PSC Development Meet. 'Recreational' swimmers are <i>ineligible</i> to enter. No qualifying times are required for this meet.



Visiting swimmers	<p>Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, or from Interstate, are permitted to swim.</p> <p>A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their first name and the Federation they are registered with.</p> <p>Inter-State swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their surname and the club they are registered with.</p> <p>Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form.</p> <p>There will be no manual entries accepted.</p>
Events	<p>As per the attached Program of Events.</p> <p>This meet is to be conducted as timed finals. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, PSC reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. PSC, in consultation with the chief referee, also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and / or events.</p>
Withdrawals / Refunds	<p>Any withdrawals requested prior to the closing of nominations will be fully refunded through Swim Central. After nominations have closed, <u>no</u> refunds will be given.</p>
Rules	<p>This meet will be conducted under the rules as documented within:</p> <p>"Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules.</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m.</p>
Further Communication	<p>In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees within the program. This will include the entry list, timeline, and finalised meet program, which will outline all meet specific requirements, seating allocations and any further information as required.</p>
Marshalling	<p>All swim meets within the Gold Coast region are self-marshalling.</p>
Meet Mobile	<p>Results will be published throughout this meet to the Meet Mobile application.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used as a guide only. Official meet results are printed by officials during the meet and posted in a prominent position. <p>Official results are published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet on the Swimming Gold Coast website and Swim Central.</p>
Results	<p>Age Champions will <u>not</u> be recognised at this meet.</p> <p>1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded. Medals will be awarded to the following Age groups: 8, 9, 10, 11 for 50-, 100- and 200-meter individual events only.</p>
Collection of medals	<p>Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.</p>



Timekeepers & Volunteers	Timekeepers and other volunteers may be required to be provided by each club, where available. A schedule will be provided to the clubs by the host club.
Photography & images	<p>In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They may be photographed by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club approved photographers, • The images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet, and • They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club at its discretion.
Warmup	<p>Warm-up will commence as follows: Sunday Session: 7.30am Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 0 and 9.</p>
Food	PSC will be running BBQ on the day. The Hub Café has a range of hot/cold beverages and meal options available throughout the day.
Force Majeure	In the case of force majeure preventing or any unforeseen circumstance preventing or resulting in a Gold Coast Region swimming event being cancelled, no event registration moneys paid will be refunded.
Pool Compliance	The Pimpama Sports Hub has undertaken compliance testing and have met all current competitive pool standards, as set by Swimming Australia.
Competitive Dive Policy	All swimming competitors and/or their parents, accept that, by nominating for this event, that they have read and understand Swimming Australia's "Dive Entry for Competitive Swimming Policy" and the swimmer(s) meet the dive competency levels outlined in that policy.
