Nominations Close	11:59pm, Saturday 12 th October 2024 All entries must be submitted through swim central
Entry Cap	This meet is capped at 4 hours. Meet nominations will close on Swim Central once cap is met. Swimmers are only able to enter a maximum of 6 individual events at this meet.

Age Determination	Age as at 19 th October 2024. Minimum age for this club meet is 6 years.
Late Entries	No late entries will be accepted, under any circumstances.
Warmup	Warmup commences 7:30AM Dive starts and pace work will be allocated for lanes 1 & 8
Spectators & Gate Entry	Spectators will be permitted at this event Gate Entry will be \$3.00 for spectators



	<p>All coaches, technical officials, volunteers & team managers will have their entry subsidised by Emmanuel College Swimming Club.</p>
Withdrawals / Refunds	<p>Any withdrawals requested prior to the closing of nominations will be fully refunded through Swim Central.</p> <p>After nominations have closed, all withdrawals MUST be accompanied with a medical certificate in order to receive a refund. Any medical certificate MUST be received within 48hours of the commencement of the meet and MUST be applicable the day of the meet.</p>
Code of conduct	<p>By entering this swim meet all swimmers and attendees agree to adhere to the Swimming Gold Coast code of conduct. The code of conduct can be found at the following link. CODE OF CONDUCT LINK</p>
Swimmer Eligibility	<p>All Swimmers must be fully registered as a “Competitive Swimmer” on Swim Central to nominate for the 2024 Emmanuel College Development Meet.</p> <p>‘Recreational’ swimmers are ineligible to enter.</p>
Visiting Swimmers	<p>Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, or from Interstate, are permitted to swim.</p> <p>A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their first name and the Federation they are registered with.</p> <p>Inter-State swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their surname and the club they are registered with.</p> <p>Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form.</p> <p>There will be no manual entries accepted.</p>
Events	<p>As per below Program of Events.</p> <p>Heats only will be swum in each event. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, Emmanuel College Swimming Club reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. Emmanuel College Swimming Club also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and/or events.</p>
Rules	<p>This meet will be conducted under the rules as documented within: "Swimming Queensland General Rules", "Swimming Queensland Championship By-Laws", "FINA" and "Swimming Australia Limited" rules</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone (holding area) 4 heats prior to their own heat for events up to 200m.</p>
Technical Officials	<p>All technical officials will be contacted to register their availability by Chief Referee, Sharon Wicking.</p> <p>Any persons interested in learning about the possibilities of becoming a Technical Official, please make contact with the Swimming Gold Coast Chief Referee Sharon</p>

Further Communication	<p>In the week preceding the meet, further relevant information will be provided to all participants and attendees within the program. This will include the entry list, timeline and finalised meet program, which will outline all meet specific requirements, seating allocations, food availability, club volunteer requirements etc.</p>
Marshalling	<p>All swim meets within the Gold Coast region are self-marshalling.</p> <p>Competitors in the first 2 events should be behind the blocks in the self-marshalling zone prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, all competitors should be in the self-marshalling zone 4 heats prior to their own heat.</p>
Photography & Images	<p>In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland and/or Swimming Gold Coast approved photographers. Any images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet. They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and affiliated clubs at their discretion.</p>
Timekeepers & Volunteers	<p>Timekeepers, Technical Officials, check starters and volunteers will be required to be provided by each club, where available. A schedule will be provided to the clubs by the Emmanuel College Swimming Club.</p>
Results	<p>Age Champions will not be recognised at this meet.</p> <p>1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded to the following Age Groups: 8, 9, 10, 11 for 50, 100 and 200 metre individual events only.</p> <p>There will be no medals or places awarded for 25 metre events. All participants in 25 metre events will receive participation ribbons.</p>
Collections of Medals	<p>Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.</p>
Meet Mobile	<p>Results may be published in near real time during this meet via the Meet Mobile application.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Results published via Meet Mobile ARE NOT OFFICIAL and should be used as a guide only.• Official meet results are printed by officials during all meets and posted in a prominent position. <p>Official results are also published within 48hrs of the completion of a meet upon the Swimming Gold Coast website and Swim Central.</p>



Pool Compliance	The Emmanuel College Aquatic Centre has undertaken compliance testing and met all current competitive pool standards, as set by Swimming Australia. Gold Coast pool certifications can be viewed here .
Competitive Dive Entry	All swimming competitors and/or their parents, accept that, by nominating for this event, that they have read and understand Swimming Australia's "Dive Entry for Competitive Swimming Policy" and the swimmer(s) meet the dive competency levels outlined in that policy.
